

Privacy Policy - Drill's App

Thank you for choosing to be part of our community at Drill ("appdrills.com," "company," "we," "us," or "our"). Drill's application is a part of the project, consisting of the application and website. We are committed to protecting your personal information and your right to privacy. If you have any questions or concerns about our policy or practices concerning your personal information, please contact us at support@appdrills.com.

We take your privacy very seriously. When you visit and use our services, you trust us with your personal information. In this privacy notice, we describe our privacy policy. We seek to explain to you the most transparent way possible what information we collect, how we use it, and what rights you have concerning it. We hope you take the time to read it carefully, as it is crucial. If there are any terms in this privacy policy that you disagree with, please discontinue the use of our services.

This privacy policy applies to all information collected through our and/or any related services, sales, marketing, or events (we refer to them collectively in this privacy policy as the "Sites").

Please read this privacy policy carefully, as it will help you make informed decisions about sharing your personal information with us.

WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

The personal information you disclose to us

In Short: We may collect the personal information you provide us, such as name, address, contact information, passwords and security data, and payment information.

We collect the personal information you voluntarily provide us when registering, expressing an interest in obtaining information about us or our products and services, participating in activities in Drill or https://www.appdrills.com/ website, or otherwise contacting us.

The personal information we collect depends on the context of your interactions with us and Drill, your choices, and the products and features you use. The personal information we collect can include the following:

Name and Contact Data. We may collect your first and last name, email address, postal address, phone number, and other similar contact data.

Credentials. We collect passwords, password hints, and similar security information used for authentication and account access.

Payment Data. We collect data necessary to process your payment if you make purchases, such as your payment instrument number (such as a credit card number) and the security code associated with your payment instrument. Our payment processor stores all payment data, and you should review its privacy policies and contact the payment processor directly to respond to your questions.

Drill offers an in-app purchase option as a subscription for the extra functionality, which may be unblocked by subscribing. This subscription is auto-renewing and allows users to get what they have paid for without performing additional tasks, such as posting on social media, uploading contacts, checking in to the app a certain number of times, etc. The subscription period lasts at least seven days and is available across all user devices. Before asking a customer to subscribe, the Drill's application gives detailed information about what specific features the user will



All the personal information you provide must be true, complete, and accurate, and you must notify us of any changes to such personal information.

INFORMATION AUTOMATICALLY COLLECTED

In Short: Some information – such as IP address and/or browser and device characteristics – is automatically collected when you use our site.

We automatically collect certain information when visiting, using, or navigating https://www.appdrills.com. This information does not reveal your specific identity (like your name or contact information). However, it may include device and usage information, such as your IP address, browser and device characteristics, operating system, language preferences, referring URLs, device name, country, location, information about how and when you use our, and other technical information. This information is primarily needed to maintain the security and operation of Drill and for our internal analytics and reporting purposes.

WILL YOUR INFORMATION BE SHARED WITH ANYONE?

In Short: We only share information with your consent to comply with laws, to protect your rights, or to fulfill business obligations.

We may process or share data based on the following legal basis:

Consent: We may process your data if you have given us specific consent to use your personal information for a specific purpose.

Performance of a Contract: Where we have entered into a contract with you, we may process your personal information to fulfill the terms of our contract.

We may disclose your information where we are legally required to do so in order to comply with applicable law, governmental requests, a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal processes, such as in response to a court order or a subpoena (including in response to public authorities to meet national security or law enforcement requirements).

Vital Interests: We may disclose your information where we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding potential violations of our policies, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person and illegal activities, or as evidence in litigation in which we are involved.

More specifically, we may need to process your data or share your personal information in the following situations:

Vendors, Consultants, and Other Third-Party Service Providers. We may share your data with third-party vendors, service providers, contractors, or agents who perform services for us or on our behalf and require access to such information to do that work. Examples include payment processing, data analysis, email delivery, hosting services, customer service, and marketing efforts. Unless described in this policy, we do not share, sell, rent, or trade your information with third parties for their promotional purposes.

Business Transfers. We may share or transfer your information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.



Affiliates. We may share your information with our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this privacy policy. Affiliates include our parent company and any subsidiaries, joint venture partners, or other companies we control or are under our common control.

Business Partners. We may share your information with our business partners to offer certain products, services, or promotions.

Other Users. When you share personal information or otherwise interact with public areas of Drill, such personal information may be viewed by all users

IS YOUR INFORMATION TRANSFERRED INTERNATIONALLY?

In Short: We may transfer, store, and process your information in countries other than yours.

Our servers are located in Poland and Ukraine. If you are accessing our website from outside, please be aware that your information may be transferred to, stored, and processed by us in our facilities and by those third parties with whom we may share your personal information.

WHAT IS OUR STANCE ON THIRD-PARTY WEBSITES?

In Short: We are not responsible for the safety of any information you share with third-party providers who advertise but are not affiliated with our websites.

They may contain advertisements from third parties not affiliated with us, which may link to other websites, online services, or mobile applications. We cannot guarantee the safety and privacy of the data you provide to third parties. Any data collected by third parties is not covered by this privacy policy. We are not responsible for any third parties' content or privacy and security practices and policies, including other websites, services, or applications that may be linked to or from Drill. You should review the policies of such third parties and contact them directly to respond to your questions.

HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION?

In Short: We keep your information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this privacy policy unless otherwise required by law.

We will only keep your personal information for as long as it is necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy unless a more extended retention period is required or permitted by law (such as tax, accounting, or other legal requirements).

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your personal information, we will either delete or anonymize it, or, if this is not possible (for example, because your personal information has been stored in backup archives), then we will securely store your personal information and isolate it from any further processing until deletion is possible.

HOW DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION SAFE?

In Short: We aim to protect your personal information through organizational and technical security measures.

We have implemented appropriate technical and organizational security measures designed to



protect the security of any personal information we process. However, please also remember that we cannot guarantee that the internet itself is 100% secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal information, the transmission of personal information to and from our website and applications is at your own risk. You should only access the services within a secure environment.

DO WE COLLECT INFORMATION FROM MINORS?

In Short: We do not knowingly collect data from children under 13 or sell them our products.

We do not knowingly solicit data from or market to children under 13. Using the website, you convey that you are at least 13 or are the parent or guardian of such a minor and consent to such minor dependent's use of Drill. If we learn that personal information from users less than 13 years of age has been collected, we will take reasonable measures to delete such data from our records promptly. WHAT ARE YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS?

In Short: In some regions, such as the European Economic Area, you have rights that allow you greater access to and control over your personal information. You may review, change, or terminate your account at any time

In some regions (like the European Economic Area), you have certain rights under applicable data protection laws. These may include the right (i) to request access and obtain a copy of your personal information, (ii) to request rectification or erasure; (iii) to restrict the processing of your personal information; and (iv), if applicable, to data portability. If we rely on your consent to process your personal information, you can withdraw your consent at any time. However, you should note that this will not affect the lawfulness of the processing before its withdrawal.

need to send you service-related emails necessary for the administration and use of your account.

CONTROLS FOR DO-NOT-TRACK FEATURES

Most web browsers, mobile operating systems, and mobile applications include a Do-Not-Track ("DNT") feature or setting you can activate to signal your privacy preference of not collecting and monitoring the data about your online browsing activities. No uniform technology standard for recognizing and implementing DNT signals has been finalized.
